Inventor has already been installed on your system so you do not need to download the program.


Open your browser (Chrome or Firefox) and log into SmoothWall.




On the next screen, choose United States, Student and fill in your birthdate


On the next screen, fill in your name, email and password (highly suggested you use your district email and password), click I agree then create account

This single account gives you access to all your Autodesk products




You will need your specific Serial number and Product key to license Inventor on your system.

**STOP!!** These next steps are very important and <u>must be followed</u> exactly as laid out. Open File Explorer. Under the View tab check Hidden items:




Next navigate to C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\CLM

In that path you will find a file named LGS. Right Click and delete this entire file:



# Your teacher or building tech must perform this next step!

Navigate in the start menu to Autodesk Inventor 2018 and right click Run as administrator on Autodesk Inventor Professional 2018. The teacher or tech will need to enter their credentials. Click I Agree on the next screen. Click Serial Number when the window with three options comes up



Continue through the next screens then enter the serial number and product key when prompted. Click Activate. Inventor will open automatically. Close the program and have the student open Inventor again. Inventor will open and you are ready to go!
