

Connecting your Laptop to your Network

Overview

Access to the Internet is necessary to connect your device to the resources you need for your education in the Sioux City Community School District. This document is a quick reference to get you connected.

Getting on the Internet

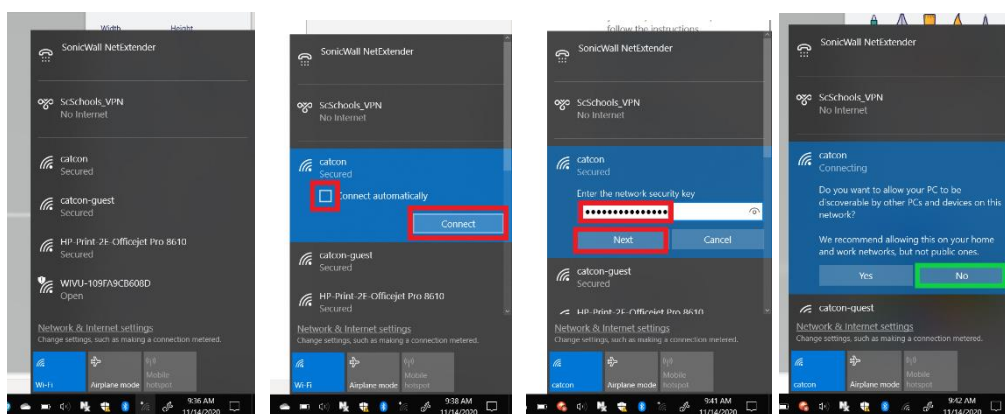
When you bring your device home you need to configure it to connect to your home network. This is going to be dependent on your network at home and we hope you are familiar with what needs to be done. What we will do is provide you with directions on where to go on your device to select your wireless network.

Here is a quick reference for connecting to wireless as taken from the Microsoft web site ([LINK](#))

1. Select the **Network** icon on the taskbar (see below). The icon that appears depends on your current connection state. If you don't see one of the network icons (or a similar one) shown in the image, select the **Up arrow** to see if it appears there.



2. Choose the Wi-Fi network you want, then select **Connect**.
3. Type the network password, and then select **Next**.
4. Choose **Yes** or **No**, depending on the type of network you're connecting to and if you want your PC to be discoverable by other PCs and devices on the network. We recommend you select No to be more secure.
